

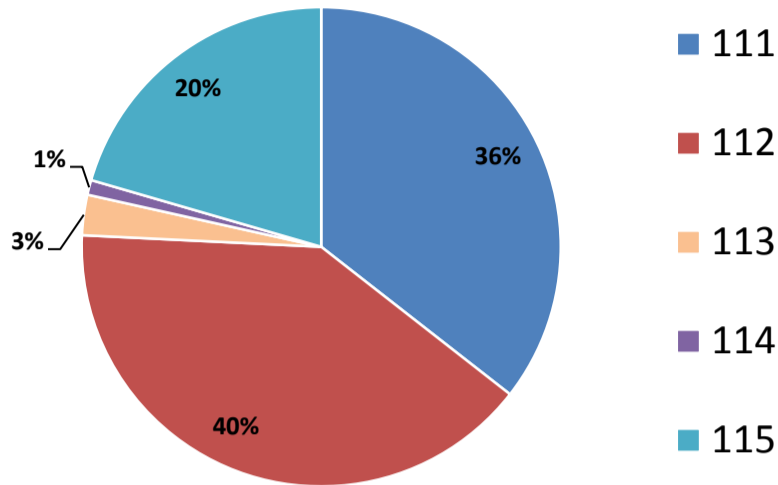

## NAICS Sector 11 - Agriculture, Forestry, Fishing and Hunting

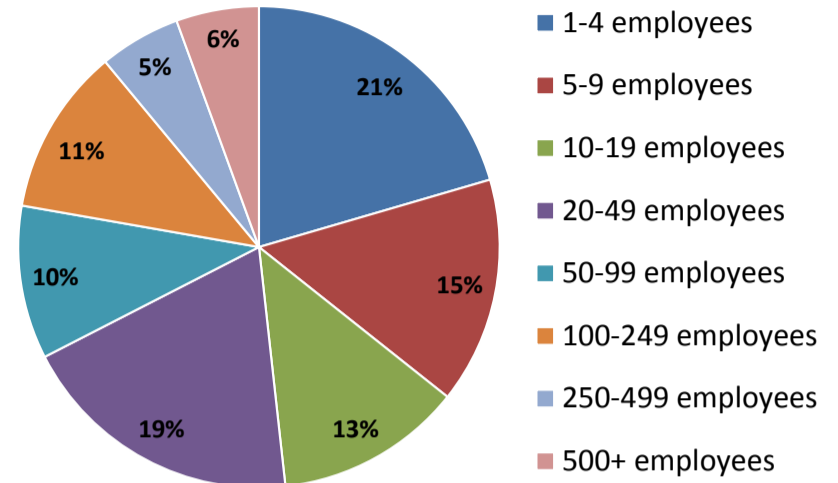
Fourth Quarter 2016

The Agriculture, Forestry, Fishing and Hunting sector comprises establishments primarily engaged in growing crops, raising animals, harvesting timber, and harvesting fish and other animals from a farm, ranch, or their natural habitats. The establishments in this sector are often described as farms, ranches, dairies, greenhouses, nurseries, orchards, or hatcheries. **Components: Crop Production-NAICS 111, Animal Production-NAICS 112, Forestry and Logging-NAICS 113, Fishing, Hunting and Trapping-NAICS 114, Support Activities for Agriculture and Forestry-NAICS 115.**

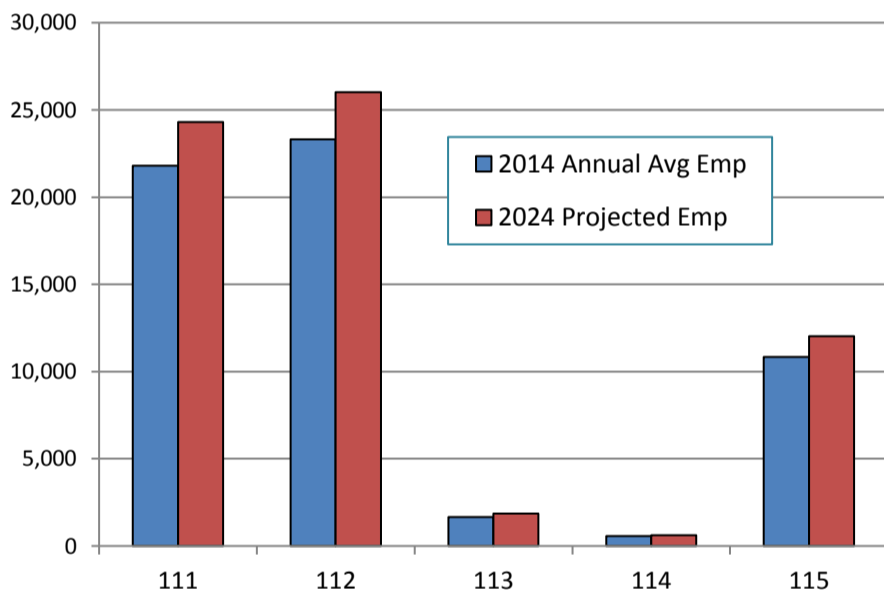
Industry Subsectors by Employment (Emp: 62,474)



Size Classes by Employment



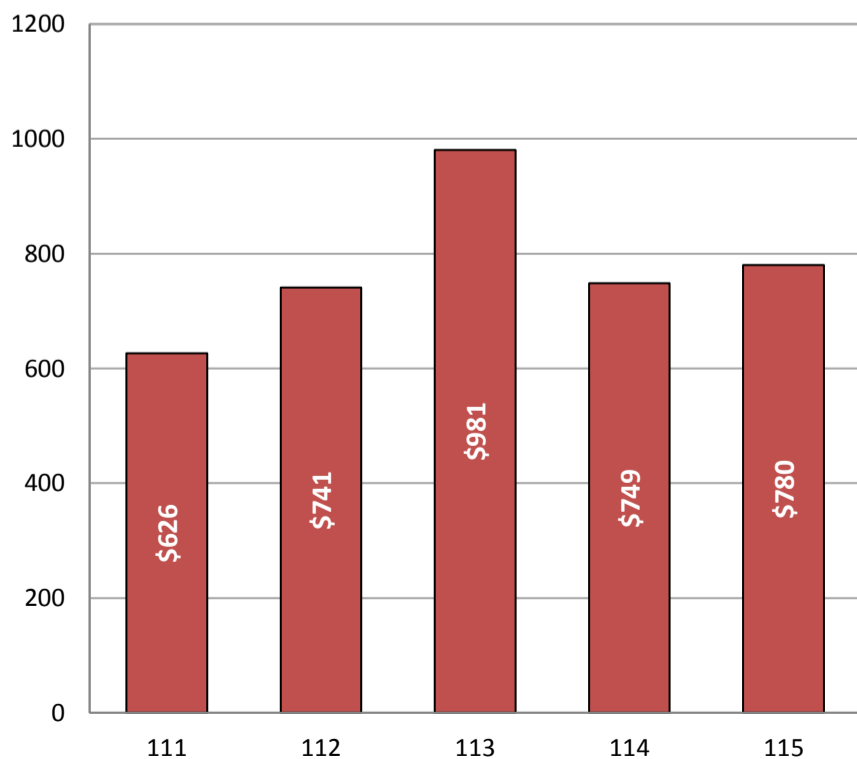
Projected Industry Employment
