

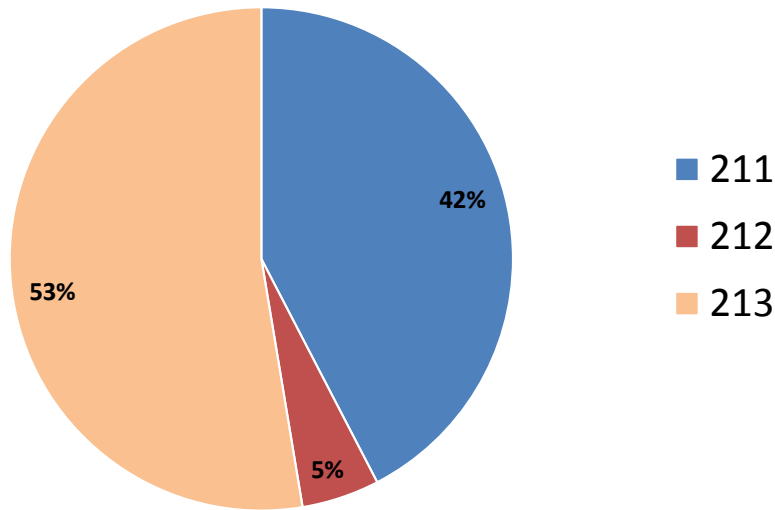

NAICS Sector 21 - Mining, Quarrying, and Oil and Gas Extraction

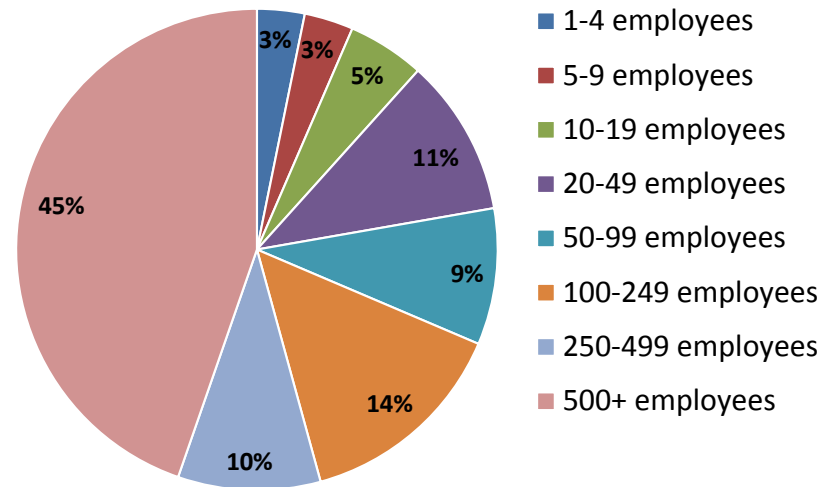
Fourth Quarter 2016

This sector comprises establishments that extract naturally occurring mineral solids, such as coal and ores; liquid minerals, such as crude petroleum; and gases, such as natural gas. The term mining is used in the broad sense to include quarrying, well operations, beneficiating (e.g., crushing, screening, washing, and flotation), and other preparation customarily performed at the mine site, or as a part of mining activity. **Components: Oil and Gas Extraction-NAICS 211, Mining (except Oil and Gas)-NAICS 212, and Support Activities for Mining-NAICS 213.**

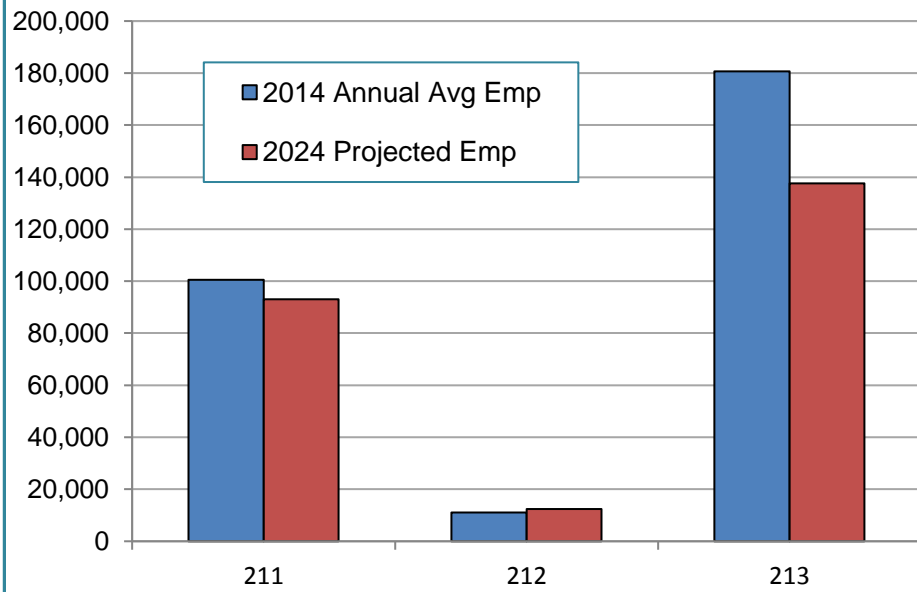
Industry Subsectors by Employment (Emp 214,106)



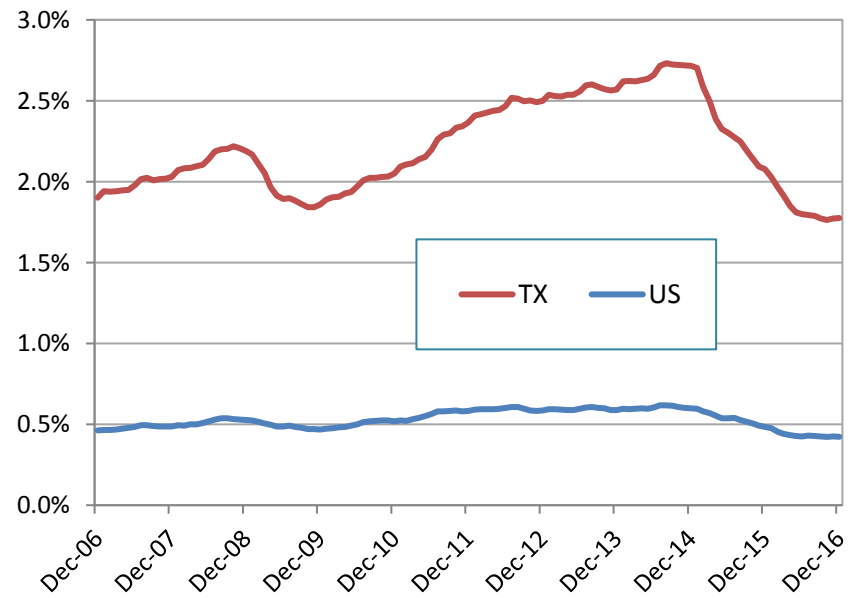
Size Classes by Employment



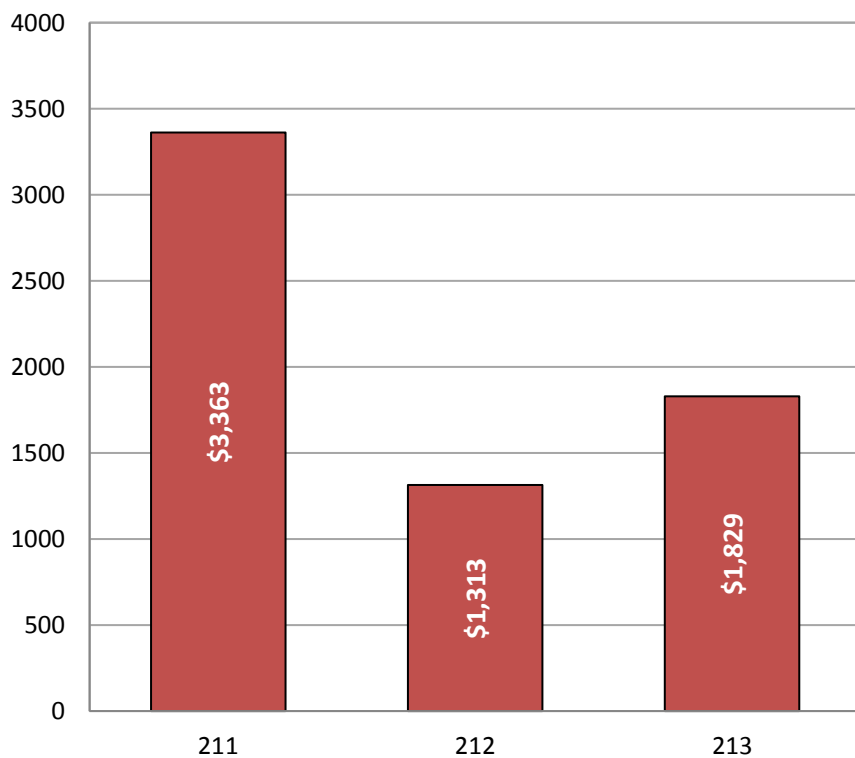
Projected Industry Employment
