

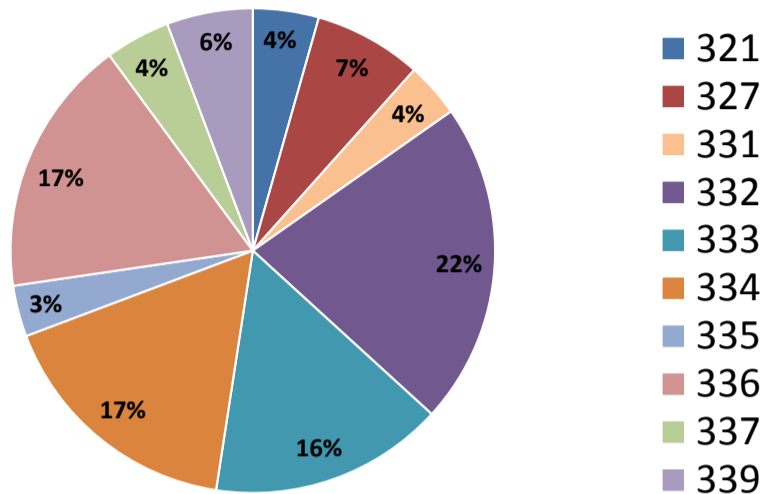

Durable Goods Manufacturing

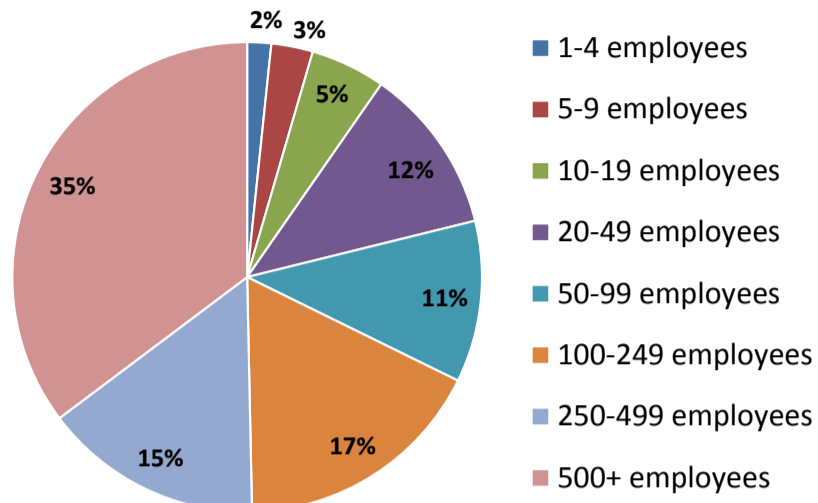
Fourth Quarter 2016

This sector comprises establishments producing consumer products that do not need to be purchased frequently because they are made to last for a long time, generally three years or more. **Components:** Wood Products Mfg-NAICS 321, Nonmetallic Mineral Products Mfg-NAICS 327, Primary Metal Mfg-NAICS 331, Fabricated Metal Product Mfg-NAICS 332, Machinery Mfg-NAICS 333, Computer & Electronic Product Mfg-NAICS 334, Electrical Equipment, Appliance, & Component Mfg-NAICS 335, Transportation Equipment Mfg-NAICS 336, Furniture & Related Product Mfg-NAICS 337, and Misc Mfg-NAICS 339.

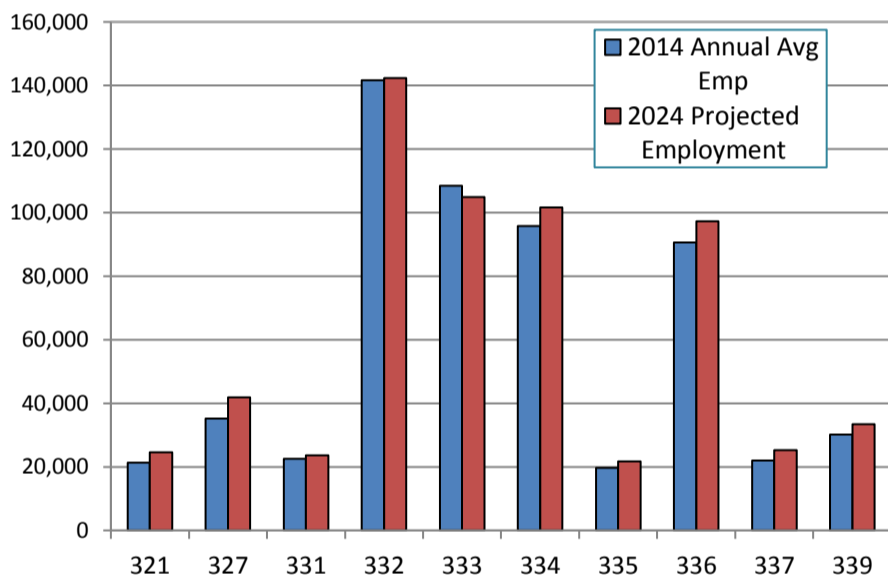
Industry Subsectors by Employment (Emp: 534,147)



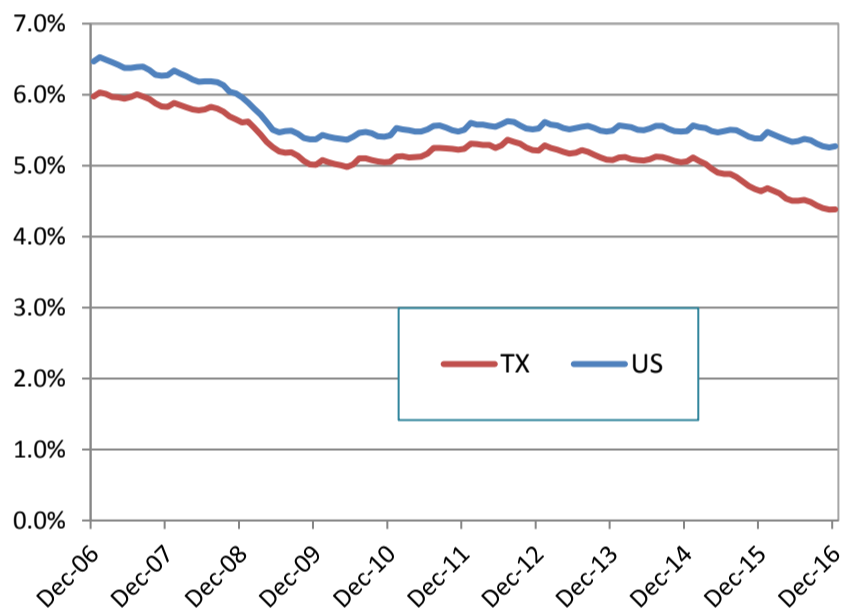
Size Classes by Employment



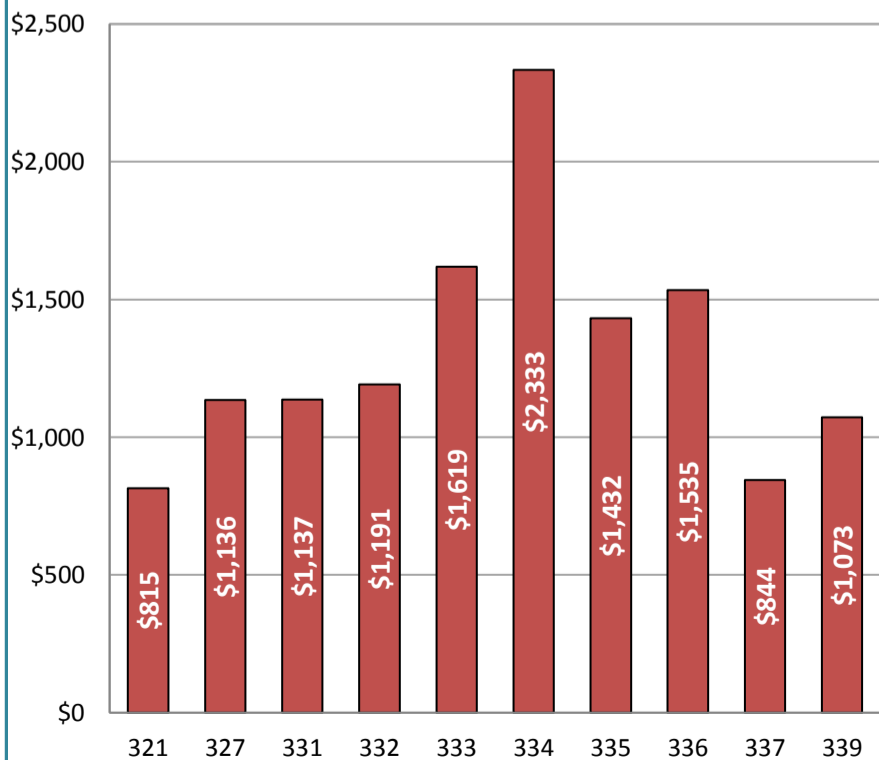
Projected Industry Employment
