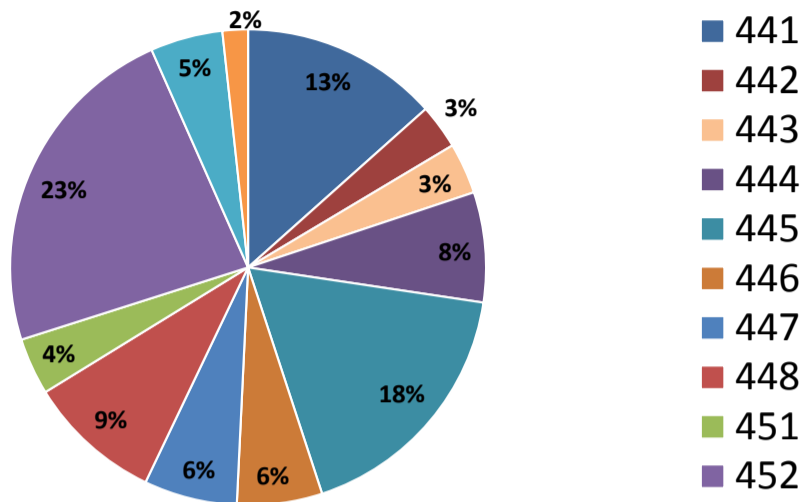


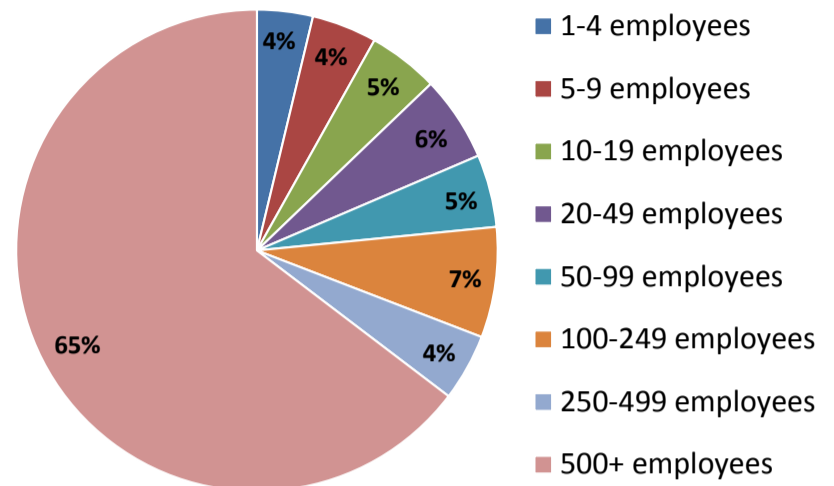
**TEXAS INDUSTRY PROFILE**  
**NAICS Sector 44-45 - Retail Trade**  
**Fourth Quarter 2016**

This sector comprises establishments engaged in retailing merchandise, generally without transformation, and rendering services incidental to the sale of merchandise. The retailing process is the final step in the distribution of merchandise. **Components:** Motor vehicle and parts dealers-NAICS 441, Furniture and home furnishings stores-NAICS 442, Electronics & Appliance Stores-NAICS 443, Building material & garden supply stores-NAICS 444, Food & beverage stores-NAICS 445, Health & personal care stores-NAICS 446, Gasoline stations-NAICS 447, Clothing & clothing accessories stores-NAICS 448, Sporting goods, hobby, book, & music stores-NAICS 451, General merchandise stores-NAICS 452, Misc. store retailers-NAICS 453, and Nonstore retailers-NAICS 454.

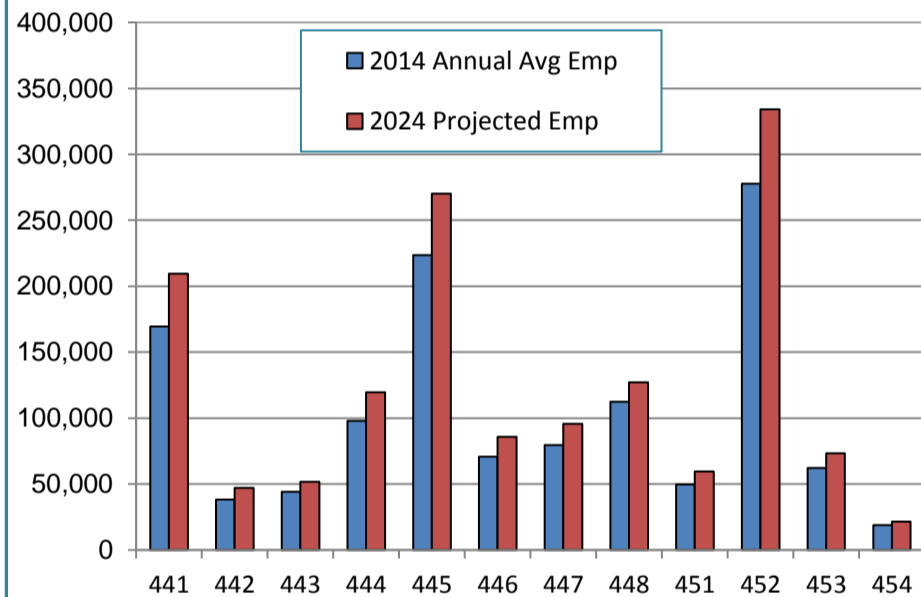
**Industry Subsectors by Employment (Emp: 1,365,542)**



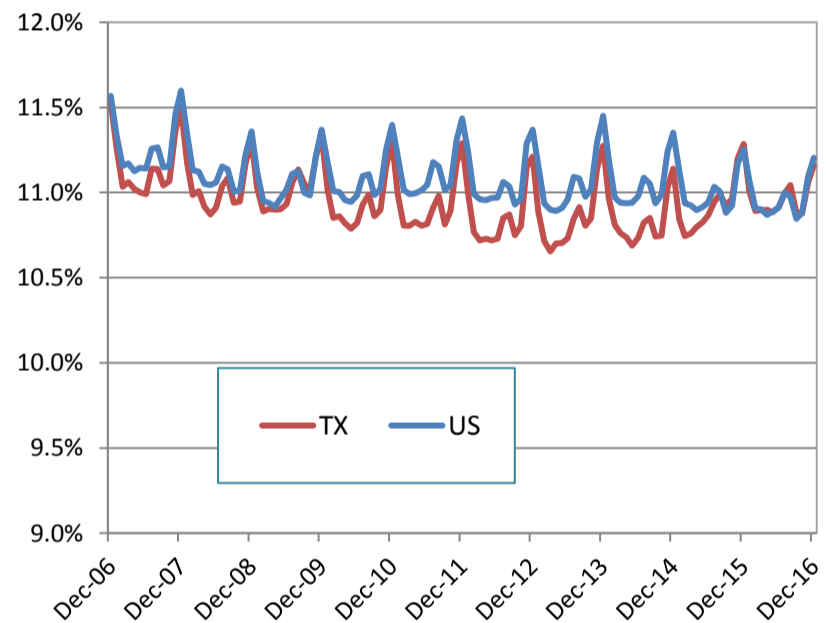
**Size Classes by Employment**



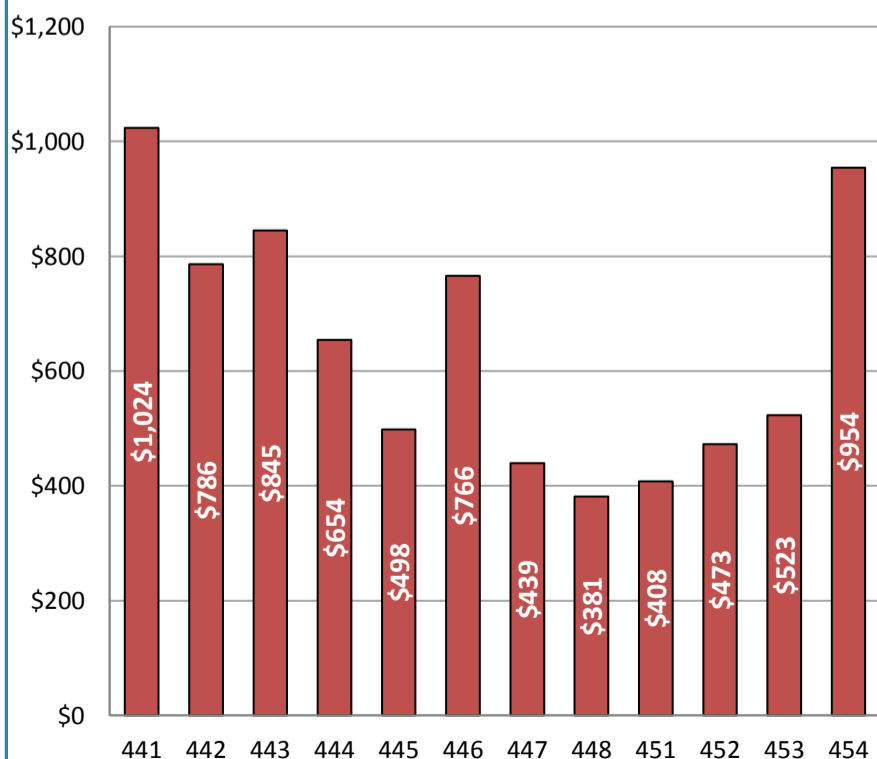
**Projected Industry Employment**
