

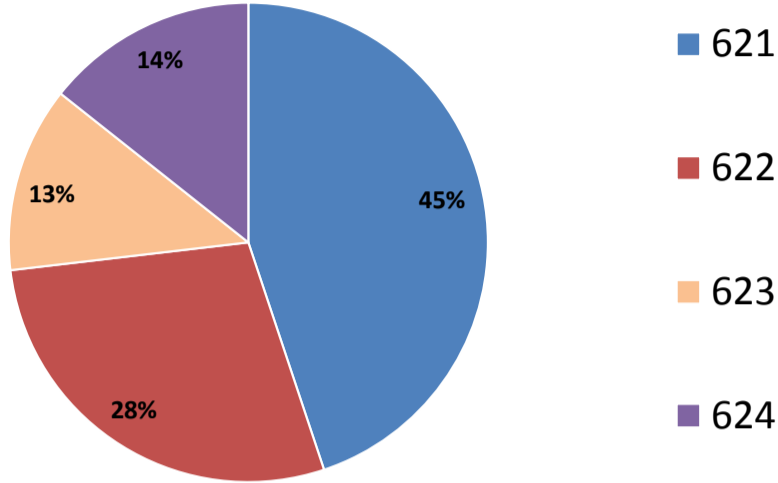
TEXAS INDUSTRY PROFILE

NAICS Sector 62 - Health Care and Social Assistance

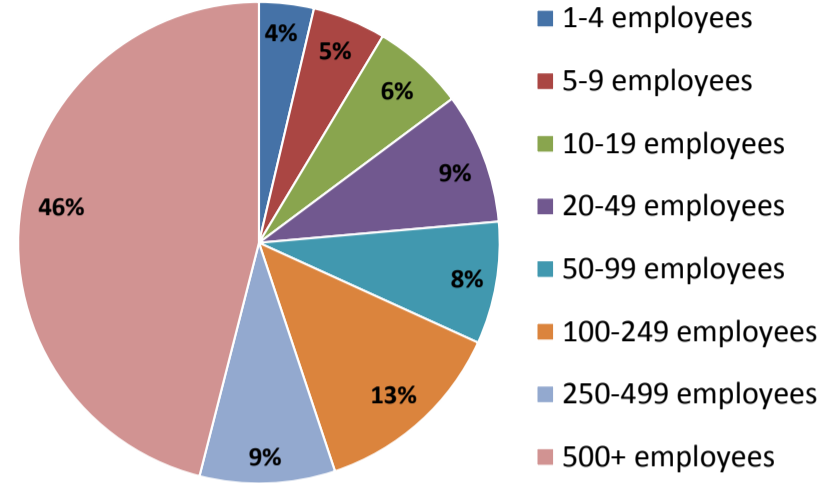
Fourth Quarter 2016

This sector comprises establishments providing health care and social assistance for individuals. Because it is sometimes difficult to distinguish between the boundaries of these two activities, the industries in this sector are arranged on a continuum. All industries in the sector share this commonality of process, namely, labor inputs of health practitioners or social workers with the requisite expertise. Many of the industries in the sector are defined based on the educational degree held by the practitioners included in the industry. **Components: Ambulatory Health Care Services-NAICS 621, Hospitals-NAICS 622, Nursing and Residential Care Facilities-NAICS 623, and Social Assistance-NAICS 624.**

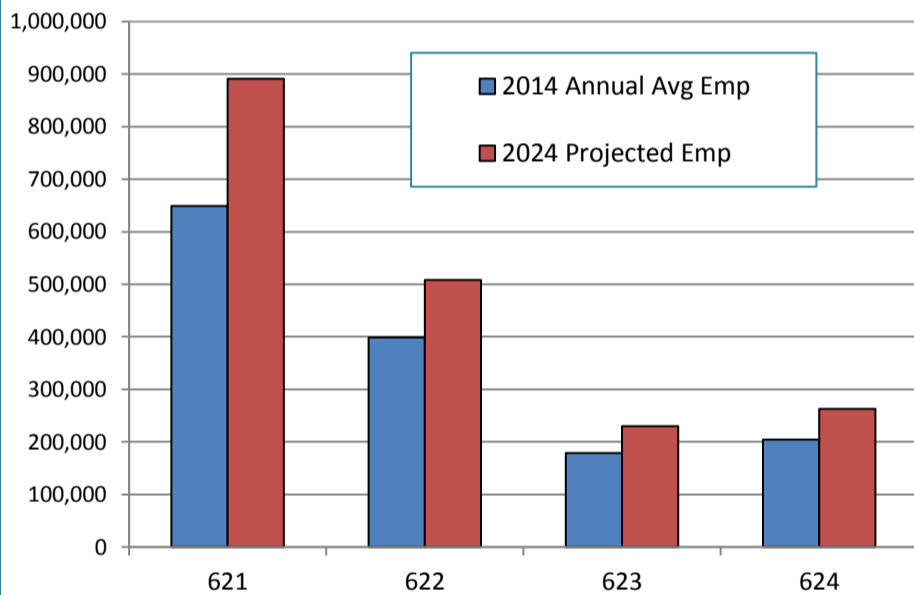
Industry Subsectors by Employment (Emp: 1,617,439)



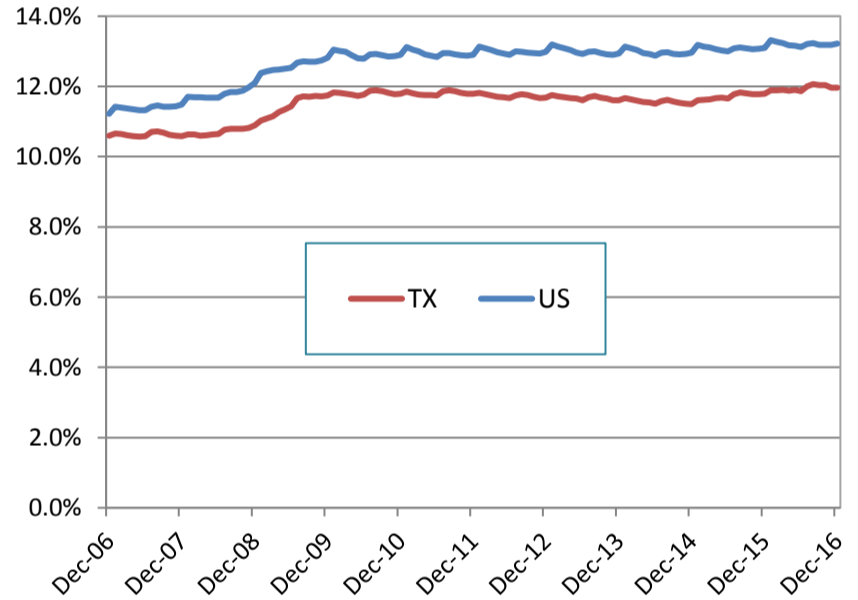
Size Classes by Employment



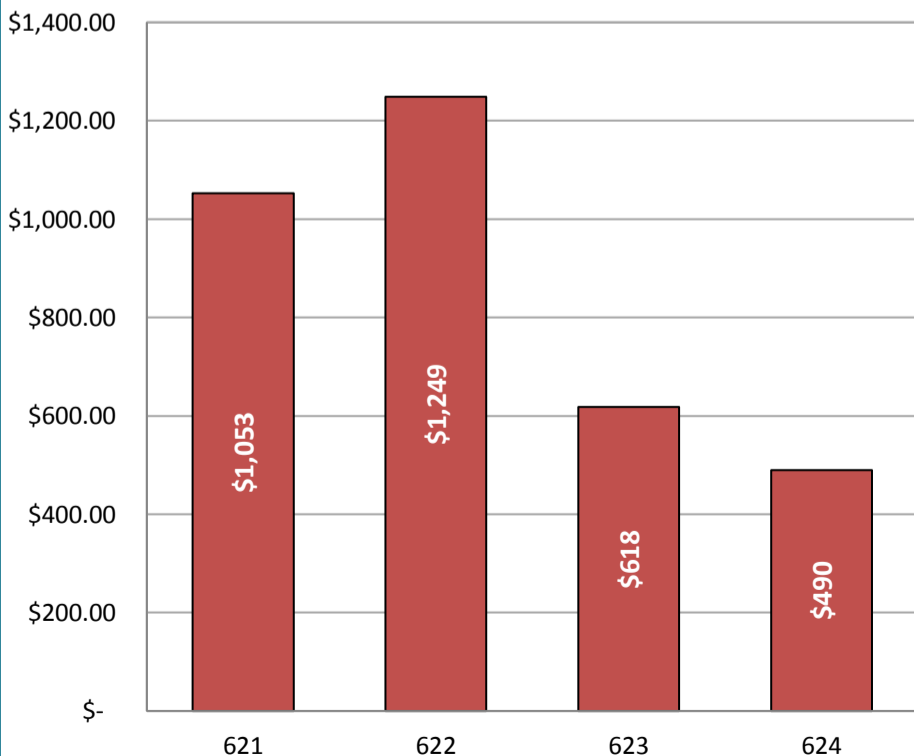
Projected Industry Employment
